RULES OF USE

RULES OF USE

1. - AIM

The purpose of these regulations is to establish clear rules for the use of the Club, so that the members may properly utilize our facilities. They also intend to regulate the circumstances under which the installations may be opened to non-members.

2. - ENTRANCE TO THE CLUB: ACCES PASSES

Members who are up to date in the payment of monthly quotas, have the right to use and enjoy the installations and are obliged to present their membership cards (access passes) upon the management's request or upon the request of the person(s) thereby authorized. It is understood that the Club's watchmen and the Restaurant's employees are entitled to ask the users for the presentation of the membership cards.

Since the Club's shares have the consideration of family shares, **it shall be considered a beneficiary of a share the person bearing an access pass** in the name of the shareholder -be it a company or an individual person. Each share provides the right to have six (6) access passes to use the Club.

3. - GUESTS

A shareholder is entitled to invite guests to the Club and use every facility provided that each of these guests presents the corresponding access pass referred to in the preceding paragraph, or shows an invitation ticket granted by a member To this end the Club will give each member on an annual basis 20 one-day invitation tickets that will entitle the bearer to use every facility. For the **admission of guests without an access pass or an invitation ticket** here are the conditions to be met:

3.1. - It becomes indispensable that the member announces in advance to the watch service the number of invited guests.

3.2. - The inviting member shall be responsible of his/her guests' behaviour while these are in the Club.

3.3. - During the **high season** (Easter Week and the months of July and August) **invitations shall be limited to the restaurant service** opened to the public the rest of the year. Guests will not be allowed to utilize other services or facilities.

The above rules notwithstanding, the Club's management retains the right to temporarily modify them in special cases such as extraordinary social events, conferences, tournaments etc.

3.4. - During the low season, non-members are also entitled to use the paddle and tennis courts subject to the conditions detailed on article 9 of the present rules.

4. - USERS

People wishing to use the installations that are neither members nor guests and have no access passes, shall be subject to these conditions:

4.1. - They will only have free access to the restaurant

4.2. - The Club retains the right to admit or reject users

4.3. - Users are responsible of whatever damages incurred into while they are in the Club

5. - CLUBHOUSE AREAS

5.1. - SOCIAL LOUNGE. Members aged over 14 and their guests bearing an access pass are entitled to use the social lounge areas. Children less than 14 will only have access to these areas provided that an adult who shall be responsible of the formers' behaviour accompanies them.

5.2. - RECEPTION. The main entrance door and its annexed rooms integrate this area destined to the watch services, secretariat and management of the Club.

Since reception is the main access door to the clubhouse, it is recommended to stay there during the time strictly necessary.

5.3. - RESTAURANT. This area is of free access to non-members except in the high season (July, August and Easter Week.) The Club's management is entitled to admit or reject guests –apart from the catering company's right to do so.

The restaurant, the sun bed areas and the summer terraces will be the only areas where meals and drinks can be served.

All users must keep outward personal appearance.

5.4. - ADULTS CARDPLAYING AREAS. This place is exclusively reserved for adult members and their guests. Card games, draughts, chest etc., will be played here.

The above rules notwithstanding, the Club's management retains the right to temporarily modify them in special cases such as extraordinary social events, conferences, tournaments etc.

5.5. - CHILDRENS AREA

This area shall be destined for the enjoyment of the members' children. The zone shall include a dining area. Members shall be responsible of the damages incurred into by their children for the misuse of the facilities.

5.6. - SHOWERS AND RESTROOMS.

These are the rooms where members and their guests may change clothes and take care of their personal hygiene.

Users are kindly requested to take care for the showers and restrooms to look clean and proper, closing taps once utilized and using disposal containers. It is recommended to use appropriate shoes in these areas. Smoking is not permitted here.

6. - SUMMER TERRACES

6.1. - These areas are of free access to non-members except in the high season (July, August and Easter Week.) The Club's management is entitled to admit or reject guests –apart from the catering company's right to do so.

7. - SWIMMING POOL.

7.1. - Members and their guests bearing an access pass or an invitation ticket are entitled to use the swimming pool during the summer season as established by the Club's management.

7.2. - The use of the swimming pools will be subject to a timetable that shall be visible at the secretariat and on the notice board.

7.3. - A life-saving service as well as a watch service shall be available within the authorized timetable –as it is required by Spanish regulations.

7.4 Wearing a bathing suit is mandatory. Available showers at the pool's area must be utilized before using the pool.

8. - OTHER AREAS

All remaining areas not mentioned on the above paragraphs shall be destined to the Club's management and services.

The Board will fix the Secretariat's working hours.

9. - USE OF THE PADDLE AND TENNIS COURTS

9.1. - Along the high season (July, August and the Easter Week) paddle and tennis courts are exclusively reserved to the members or to those persons bearing an access pass or an invitation ticket granted by a member. In view of the actual demand of courses, the Club's Management shall be entitled to determine whether the requirement for all four players to show an access pass or an invitation ticket should be limited to the daily period of maximum demand, i.e. from 18.00 hrs to 21.00 hrs. Other than the mentioned hours, a minimum of two players per court will have to present an access pass or an invitation ticket during the high season.

9.2. - During the rest of the year non-members can use the courts provided that at least one of the players is a member or bears an access pass. As far as the appropriate clothes to be worn by players, the Club shall respect the rules of Spain's Royal Federation of Tennis. Bathing suits or undershirts are not permitted.

9.3. - The Club declines any responsibility derived from accidents occurred to players while practicing paddle or tennis. That is why it is highly recommended for the players to have the corresponding official license provided by the Federation. The license provides a wide insurance coverage in case of accident.

9.4. - Courts will be used in shifts of one hour each. The Club's management shall be entitled to modify this time limitation if special circumstances so demand.

9.5. - Members can make court reservations in advance –either by telephone or directly to the court attendant. The latter will take note of each booking on the corresponding notebook specifying players' names, assigned time and court number.

It is mandatory for the players having made a reservation to be at the club with enough time in advance. They shall wait at the court's door until their booking time arrives.

9.6. - In cases when all courts are occupied and there are people waiting without a previous reservation, the attendant will prepare a waiting list. As soon as a court is available the first listed match will use it.

9.7. - Every member is entitled to use a court once a day. This limitation will not be applicable when the number of reservations allows a higher occupancy rate per person.

9.8. - The Club's management is entitled to reserve a given number of courts on the occasion of special events such as social competitions, trainings etc. Visible notices shall be placed to properly inform the members. In case of bad weather conditions or due to other justified reason, the tennis attendant will inform the Secretariat, which will decide about keeping the courts closed or opened successively.

9.9. - The Club's management will determine the number of courts as well as timetables that shall be destined to individual or collective paddle or tennis classes. Any possible modification shall be immediately notified.

10. - TENNIS CLASSES

10.1. - Both members and their guests bearing an access pass are entitled to book a tennis class.

10.2. - The Club's management will establish the basis regarding tennis classes as well as tennis competitions.

10.3. - Paddle and tennis teachers will be in the Club at their pupils' disposal at the respective booked hours.

In case of bad weather conditions, teachers will remain at the Club and shall be available to teach their pupils a theoretical lesson at the clubhouse if the latter's so wish.

10.4. - The tennis teaching service is to be hired by full hours. Members using this service will pay at the Secretariat the fees authorized by the Club's management.

10.5. - During the one-hour tennis class, there will be at least 50 minutes of effective teaching. When bad weather conditions impede the practice of tennis, pupils will pay for the class recovering later on the missed session. If the reason for the lack of a class is the teacher's responsibility (injury, disease etc) then pupils shall not pay the missed session. Members, who have booked a class and wish to cancel it, should do it four days in advance. Otherwise the class must be fully paid.

10.6. - Individual tennis classes shall take place during the morning. The Club's management will determine both timetables and courts to be used for such purpose.

11. - CLOTHES

It is expressly forbidden to stay or transit along the paddle and tennis wearing a bathing suit.

12. - MEMBERS' RESPONSIBILITY

Members shall be responsible of any damages they incur into as well as their relatives or guests'. They shall also be responsible of the latter's behaviour.

13. - RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CLUB

13.1. - The Club declines any responsibility for lost money or missed articles on its premises. It also declines any responsibility for injures or accidents that might occur.

13.2. - The Board has the right to adopt special measurements to correct and punish those members, guests or users who do not respect the above rules of use. The Board is also entitled to establish special access and use regulations when specific circumstances so require such as social events, assemblies, tennis competitions etc.

14. - MODIFICATION OF THE PRESENT RULES OF USE

The Club's General Assembly is entitles to modify the current rules with a qualified majority 201 vote.
